

## BUSHRANGER NOMINATIONS FOR MAY 2005

All orienteers who did not represent Australia at WOC 2004 in Sweden are eligible and encouraged to nominate.

The challenge is being run in Australia and is in conjunction with the Australian WOC selection trials. The trials will be held in central Victoria, ie Daylesford and south of Ballarat on the last weekend in May 2005.

The Aus – Nz test will be run concurrent with all the selection races.

Middle Distance Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> May , south of Ballarat.
