

## Renewal of Eventor license

The Eventor license is up for renewal later this year and discussions are currently in progress with the Swedish federation (SOFT) over its renewal.

We have been advised that there will be no change in our annual fee for the “main” Eventor license (200,000 SEK – approximately \$32,000 at current exchange rates). We have also been offered two possible additional services:

- (a) Integration of Winsplits into Eventor. This would allow splits to be uploaded directly through Eventor without requiring a separate upload to Winsplits, saving some work for event organisers. (Cost: 25,000 SEK per year – approximately \$3,800).
- (b) Access to o-maps, which is an online map database which utilises the Eventor permissions to restrict access. This would be free for 2017 and then 10,000 SEK (about \$1,500). This functionality is currently not generally available in Australia, although some clubs/states have their own systems of various kinds.

(Livelox is not owned by SOFT and any collective license agreement would have to be negotiated separately with the developer. We believe it is unlikely that this could be done at a realistic cost).

### Request for input from states

OA seeks the input of states at the SGM as to whether they would like to take up either or both of the additional services described above. We will also be taking advice from the Mapping Committee with respect to o-maps.

We will only pursue these additional services if there is a clear view in support of doing so. Should we do so, the additional costs would be split between States in the same way as the current Eventor license.
